Wine Spectator • 91-94/100

This is quite rich, with lots of creamed Meyer lemon, macadamia nut, white asparagus, bitter almond and paraffin notes still to meld fully. Offers plenty of zip through the finish. Should be a winner when this rounds into form.JS

Jancis Robinson • 16,5/20

Lots of smoky, toasty oak. Strong grapefruit flavour combines with the oak spice to give strident flavours that probably need to tone down a bit in the bottle. But there is plenty of substance, even if it is a touch aggressive in youth. (JH) 13.5%. Drink 2015-2022

Wine Enthusiast • 92/100 • 5/11/2012

Barrel sample. A lively, bright wine that's not too weighty. It has notes of mineral and citrus, with attractive acidity and just the right amount of balancing weight.

Decanter • 16,5/20

Nicely concentrated grapefruity nose with dry honey fruit, firm and long. A very good wine from this château. Drink 2014-2020.

Bettane et Desseauve • 17/20

Peu de fruit au nez mais bouche superbe de gras et de tension, et caractère individuel très appréciable.

GaultMillau • 16.5/20

D'agrumes certes, mais aussi de noix de coco et de vanille, que le fruité juteux de la mirabelle vient enlacer. Un moment de plaisir suave et très sensuel.
